Online and hybrid courses

Online Courses

In an online course, students interact with their instructor and classmates through the Internet. There are usually no campus visits required. If you take an online class, you will read lectures, submit assignments, take quizzes, and do other course activities online.

Parkland online courses follow the same schedule as traditional classes, and students are required to complete work each week.

Hybrid Courses

Hybrid courses meet less often than traditional college classes — often only once a week. Students are required to participate in class each week and to complete weekly course work either online, in the Center for Academic Success, or in approved service projects in the community. Guidelines are provided in your course syllabus.

DEFINITIONS:

Online hybrid — in-class participation plus weekly online instruction

Service learning hybrid — in-class participation plus service projects in the community that have been approved by the instructor

Cooperative learning hybrid — in-class participation plus weekly participation in small groups in the Center for Academic Success
