

Assessment/Testing Center Policies

PROHIBITED ITEMS INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- Cell phones (must be OFF and placed in locker with other belongings)
- Jackets, coats (hooded or pocketed shirts/sweaters/sweatshirts, subject to approval and inspection)
- Hats/caps, headwear, head coverings, scarves, etc. (religious/cultural apparel allowed)
- Any electronic device (MP3 players, iPods, headphones, etc.) (Calculators – unless allowed for exam)
- Backpacks, tote bags, purses, etc.
- Firearms/Weapons, including pocket knives and multi-tools
- Keys, sunglasses, watches (all styles – analog, digital, smart, etc.)
- Food and drink, gum and candy, including bottled water
- Personal tissues and cough drops (must be unwrapped before entering)
- Personal books/notebooks, scratch paper, pens, pencils (individual test allowances may vary)
- Children may not be left unattended
