Any bid not received by said time and date will not be considered. Bids sent by facsimile machine or email will not be accepted.

All bidders are welcome to attend the public bid opening. No information regarding the recommendation to the Board of Trustees will be released until after the Board of Trustees meet on March 26, 2025.

The Board of Trustees of Parkland College reserves the right to reject all or any part of a bid submitted, to waive any technicalities or informalities in the bidding, and to accept bids or combination of a bid deemed most favorable to and in the best interest of the college after all bids have been examined and evaluated. All bidders must fully comply with all local, state, and federal laws regarding bidding on public projects and the performance of services or supplying of goods under a bid.

- 1. All bid prices shall be complete and include warranty and delivery.
- 2. Contract will be an official Parkland College purchase order to be issued after approval of the bid by the Board of Trustees.
- 3. Payment shall be made in accordance with these specifications and the bid proposal submitted by the bidder. Bid will be valid for a period of sixty days from date of bid opening.
- 4. Any exceptions or deviations from the bid specifications must be addressed in writing and submitted with the bid.
- 5. Parkland College is tax exempt. A copy of the exemption certificate will be furnished on request.

Any bid not received by said time and at said place will not be considered. Bids sent by facsimile machine or email will not be accepted. The bids will be publicly opened and announced at 2:00 p.m. CST on Tuesday, February 11, 2025, Room A108 on the Parkland College campus. No decision will be made at that time.

Scope:

Parkland College is soliciting bids from qualified vendors to design, build, and deliver interactive career exploration carts aimed at engaging youth aged 12-17. These carts should provide hands-on, educational activities that spark interest in a variety of career fields. **Of specific interest are carts with activities for careers in welding, advanced manufacturing, automotive, agricultural, electrical, and health professions.** The project aims to encourage career exploration by integrating technology, creativity, and interactivity into portable and durable carts.

General:

These are the specifications required for the six career exploration carts. Bidders must answer all questions. Any unanswered questions will be considered noncompliant and nonresponsive and subject to rejection.

Business Enterprise for Minorities, Females, and Persons with Disabilities:

Consistent with the Business Enterprise for Minorities, Females, and Persons with Disabilities Act, 30 ILCS 575/0.01, *et seq.* (the "Act"), it is the policy of Parkland College to foster and encourage the continued economic development of minority owned businesses, female owned businesses, and businesses owned by a person with a disability.
