This is to acknowledge that Parkland College District No. 505 is in receipt of your *Freedom of Information Act* (FOIA) request submitted on March 8, 2022, for the following records:

"...your school's total compensation in payroll expenditures for the 2019-2020 school year for the athletic department, including salary and all additional payments. This request includes all schools within your college system. This request includes, but is not limited to, the following information:

- Last name
- First name
- Middle name (or initial, if available)
- Suffix (e.g. Jr., if available)
- Title
- Department
- Annual Base Salary
- Overtime, holiday pay, bonus compensation and any other additional payments made to employees excluding costs such as insurance, pension or benefit payments
- Start date

Please include compensation for any and all appointed officials as well."
