confirmed that "it" was Mbuta's penis. I asked [redacted] if she believed Mbuta was attempting to pleasure himself. [redacted] said yes and that she also heard him make "small moaning noises." [redacted] stated that Mbuta was "staring directly at her 'privates.'" I asked [redacted] how this made her feel. [redacted] stated, "I got disturbed; it was very uncomfortable...disgusting." [redacted] said she attempted to shuffle her books and make noise to see if Mbuta would stop. When Mbuta did not stop so she stood up to leave. [redacted] stated that when she stood up, Mbuta quickly removed his hands from his pants.

At this time, Sgt. Kopmann and Ofc. Corray were dispatched to the area to attempt to locate the suspect. While en route, Ofc. Corray encountered an individual (Mbuta) that matched the dispatched clothing description. It should also be noted that a similar incident occurred on 4/10/19 (Case 190070) in the L Wing. See Sgt. Kopmann's supplementary report.

I asked [redacted] if she was still on campus and willing to identify the suspect. I met with [redacted] by the D1 entrance at approximately 1400 hours. When I met [redacted] she was still visibly upset. I escorted [redacted] to the X Wing College Center where Sgt. Kopmann and Ofc. Corray were speaking with Mbuta with assistance from faculty member Ndoye acting as a translator. [redacted] stated she would try to identify the suspect but did not want to be seen doing so. From the X4 doorway, she stated Mbuta's hat and clothing were an exact match. I asked how sure she was that the Mbuta was the suspect. [redacted] r stated 80% sure. At that time, I had Ofc. Corray take a picture of Mbuta's face. Ofc. Corray showed the picture to [redacted] said "that's him." [redacted] stated the suspect had black pants. Mbuta was wearing black pants. At this time, I told [redacted] she could leave.

I advised Sgt. Kopmann [redacted] confirmed Mbuta as the suspect. At 1410 hours, Mbuta was placed under arrest for Disorderly Conduct. I assisted Sgt. Kopmann in placing handcuffs on Mtuba. I stood by with Mtuba while Sgt. Kopmann conducted search incident to arrest including his book bag. Sgt. Kopmann and I escorted Mbuta to Squad 031 in the B7 parking lot. Sgt. Kopmann searched the backseat. I assisted Mtuba into the back passenger seat and secured him with the seat belt. Ofc. Murray transported Mbuta to Champaign County Satellite Jail at 1421 hours. See Ofc. Murray's supplement for additional.

NARRATIVE

On 4/15/19 (Mon) at 1348 hours, dispatch put out a description of an African male wearing a bright tribal shirt and a cap who was masturbating in the 2nd floor of the C wing approximately 15 minutes ago. Officer Corray notified dispatch that she had a male matching that description going into the C wing. At 1350 hours, Officer Corray stopped the male, later identified as Mbuta, outside C130B and I arrived shortly after. Mbuta told Officer Corray that he only spoke French.

At this point, I asked Officer Dameron to do a show up. Officer Corray and I escorted Mbuta to the Cobra Den Lounge in the X wing. Mbuta sat in a chair at a table facing West. At this point I requested a French interpreter. At 1354 hours, Ndoye arrived on scene. Ndoye is a Parkland College Faculty member and has interpreted for the Police Department before.

At 1357, I had Ndoye read Mbuta his Miranda rights from a Parkland College Department of Public Safety Police Division Statement of Miranda Rights card. Mbuta responded that he would talk for a short period of time because he had somewhere to be. The responses during this interaction were interpreted by Ndoye. I asked Mbuta if he was in the C wing. He replied yes. I asked where in the C wing. Mbuta then responded that he went to the Library to get a book. I asked him if he was masturbating in the C wing. Mbuta responded no. I then asked if he had his hands inside his pants or shirt. Mbuta showed me by leaning back in the chair, holding his cell phone with his right, and his left hand was in his pocket.

Officer Corray spoke with Officer Dameron and requested a photo of Mbuta. I asked Mbuta if we could take his photo and he agreed. Officer Corray took Mbuta's photo and met with Officer Dameron. During this time, there was a pause and I asked Ndoye if he felt Mbuta was being honest. Ndoye replied, "I do not". Ndoye also told me that [redacted] told him about a male masturbating in the C wing. Ndoye said that he told [redacted] to talk to the Police Department. I asked Mbuta why someone would tell us he was masturbating in the C wing. He replied via Ndoye, "No, not sure why. I don't believe it".

At 1403 hours, Officer Dameron informed me of a positive identification by the victim, [redacted] Officer Dameron, Officer Corray, and I were at the table with Mbuta and Ndoye. I told Mbuta he was under arrest for Disorderly Conduct. I put his right hand behind his back and Officer Dameron put his left hand behind his back. Around 1407 hours, I secured Mbuta in handcuffs, checked for proper fit, and double locked the cuffs. I searched Mbuta and his backpack incident to arrest.

At 1410 hours, Officer Dameron and I escorted Mbuta to Squad 31, which was in the B7 parking lot. Officer Corray obtained Ndoye's identifying information and cleared the incident. While walking Mbuta to the squad car I said, "Do you speak English?" Mbuta responded in English, "I am taking classes to speak English, did you see my book". I asked him if he was masturbating upstairs. He replied, "No" and smiled. This smile was a whole mouth smile with his bottom and top teeth showing.

At 1415 hours, Officer Dameron secured Mbuta in the rear seat caged portion of squad 31 and secured his seat belt. I stood by until Officer Murray arrived at 1421 hours to transport Mbuta to the Champaign County Satellite Jail.

She knew the day was a Tuesday or Thursday because of her class schedule, but was unaware of the exact date. I later found that the date of the incident was March 28, 2018 because _____ spoke to Officer Bermingham originally. Officer Bermingham posted the date in the Parkland College Police Department notes area of _____

my.parkland.edu, which is used as a pass log for information. was sitting by herself and an African male walked past her, back by her, and past her again. He then walked up to her and said, "Hi". said she knew he was African because the way he spoke. It should be noted that is African as well.

friend from class, who she was unaware of her name, but said she had Psychology 101 with, arrived and sat next to her, facing . was facing West and her friend was facing East. The male came up to them again and motioned to sit down. He sat next to friend and began starring at the friend. then noticed that the male was "playing with himself". The male was looking up and down at the friend and then scooted closer. Ndoye's friend was unable to see the male so asked her if she wanted to go to class early. The male then looked over and made eye contact with . The male had his phone in his right hand with his left hand stroking his penis from inside his left pants pocket. said he had his phone out, but was not paying any attention to his phone. went on to say he then put his phone in his left hand and began "masturbating". During the incident said she could see the male's penis was erect because she could see the outline. identified as a nursing student and said she knew exactly what she saw.

described the male as African with dark black skin, brown eyes, with short black hair. She said he was around 5'5", but definitely not 6' tall. said everyone seems taller to her because she is 5'1". The male couldn't speak much English and when he said "Hi" it was broken English. The male was wearing a snap back baseball cap, some type of camouflaged windbreaker type fabric jacket, and orange athletic shoes. It should be noted that this description, behavior, and actions match other cases involving Jeremie Mbuta. Mbuta was arrested on 4/15/19 for Disorderly Conduct for very similar actions. Mbuta is also a French speaking, African male student at Parkland College who is taking English as a Second Language courses.

At this point, I asked if she would be willing to look at a photo lineup. agreed and I got Sgt. Boltinghouse to administer the photo lineup. See Sgt. Boltinhouse's supplemental report for more information. After the photo lineup was complete, I spoke with about the original reporting to an officer. It was discovered the officer was Officer Bermingham and that information was included in this case report. eliminated 4 of the photos in the lineup. She told Sgt. Boltinghouse that she was almost certain that it was 4, however couldn't say for certain, and didn't want to rule out 5.

On 4/18/19 I spoke with Brooke Hinman from the Champaign County State's Attorney's Office about this case and case 190075. Hinman is the attorney for case 190075. Hinman instructed that public indecency (720 ILCS 5/11-30(a)(2)) would be charged because Mbuta was at Parkland College knowingly engaged in an act of sexual conduct with the intent to arouse his sexual desires by masturbating in the D wing sitting area in full view of Ndoye.

She said that her boyfriend left and she saw that Mbuta was staring at her. His staring started making her uncomfortable so [redacted] asked "What's your name if you're going to stare at me?" name was Jeremie and he asked for her name and number. [redacted] said that she did not give him either. She decided to leave and she noticed that Mbuta was following her but brushed him off. He followed her to and around the Student Union until her friend's boyfriend approached them and told Mbuta to back off.

[redacted] aid that she saw Mbuta again the next day (4/2/19). [redacted] stated that she was in the C Wing study area again when Mbuta came into the area. She said that he walked around the area a couple of times, and stood behind her. [redacted] said that before she could do anything, her boyfriend showed up and scared Mbuta off.

Due to suspect development, I called [redacted] on 4/18/19 (Thurs.) to see if she could come back in and speak to me.

[redacted] stated again that she was in the first floor study lounge of C Wing with two friends and her boyfriend on 4/1/19. She said that she and her boyfriend were sitting at one table and her friends were sitting at the table next to them. One of her friends sent [redacted] a text saying that Mbuta, who was at another table, was staring at her. She said that he continued to stare after her boyfriend had left so she asked him his name. [redacted] stated that Mbuta introduced himself as Jeremie and asked for her name, which she did not give him. [redacted] said that she left to go to Financial Aid. She said that her friends texted her to let her know he was following her. [redacted] said that she even walked around a bit to see if he was following her or if it was coincidence. She said that Mbuta caught up with her after she passed Public Safety and continued to follow her.

[redacted] said that she went to the Business Office to pay a bill and to Counseling to make an advising appointment and Mbuta continued to follow her. She said that at one point, he tried to get her to sit with him and asked for her number. She told him no. [redacted] said that she was starting to get uneasy so she went into the cafeteria to grab a snack to see if he would leave, but Mbuta waited for her. Shortly after exiting the cafeteria, her friend's boyfriend approached [redacted] and told Mbuta to leave her alone.

[redacted] said that there wasn't much to the encounter the next day. [redacted] said that she was in the same study lounge again and she saw him walking around. Mbuta stood behind her but before she could say anything, her boyfriend showed up and Mbuta left.

[redacted] said that on 4/1/19 she remembered that he had on a black jacket, black backpack and a ball cap, but couldn't remember the color. He was wearing the black backpack and a shirt with an animal (maybe lion) nature scene. She felt that she could remember what he looked like and would be willing to try to identify him. I called Inv. Bermingham to follow up with [redacted]. See his supplement for details.
