Independent Study (IND 288) Agreement

IND 288 Independent Study 1-4 credit hours

Designed for students who desire a broader opportunity to examine a special problem or subject area in greater detail than the present course offerings allow. Projects may take the form of a reading course, an experiment, or any other program of learning planned jointly by student and instructor. Independent study may not be used as a substitute for any present course in the curriculum. Course may be repeated up to a total of 4 semester hours credit. Prerequisites: minimum 3.0 program GPA at Parkland College, sophomore standing, credit in two courses in the subject area, and written approval of the instructor and department chair.

Instructions: Before your enrollment in IND 288 is approved, you must submit a written statement describing your proposed study to the sponsoring instructor and appropriate department chair. Include the specific purpose of your study as well as planned activities, intended reading and writing, and methods of evaluation. Submit this completed Independent Study Agreement form to Admissions and Records (U214) when you register for IND 288.
