- > 2020: Covid/The world fell apart. Stopped participating in NCCBP.

\*\* The Illinois Peer Group consists of all the Illinois community colleges participating in the 2018 NCCBP. \* Peer group was changed from IPEDS to Illinois / NCCBP due the counts being too low (< 5) for peer comparison. (T) = Parkland is tied in the same rank as another institution.

Note: The 2017- 2018 % of Baseline column focuses on the difference (baseline) between the 2018 and 2013 values. The "baseline" value is from 2013; the first (Base) year Parkland participated in NCCBP.

A value of 100% means the current year (2018) is the same as baseline year (2013). If the value is greater than 100%, the current year exceeded baseline year.

The 2018 - 2013 % of Baseline color colding: Green = Movement in a positive direction ; Yellow = Attention may be needed; and Red= Area of needed improvement.

The Meets Overall Benchmark color colding: Green = Met or exceeded the expected benchmark; Yellow = Did not meet benchmark and attention may be needed; and Red= Did not meet the expected benchmark. Area of needed improvement.











#### 2C Credentials Awarded, 5-Year Total










#### 3A Ratio of Sections Taught by FT:PT Faculty, Fall-Term

#### 3C-1 Percentage of Minority Full-time Employees Compared to Percentage of Minority Credit Students





#### 3C-2 Percentage of Minority Faculty Compared to Percentage of Minority Credit Students





#### 4A Cost of Delivering a Credit Hour




